



FBC SEPTEMBER MISSIONS CAMPAIGN

Our commitment to Owsley County, the poorest county in Kentucky, spans over 20 years. While volunteer groups are unable to serve at the Emma Quire Mission Center (EQMC) during Covid-19, First Baptist Church Frankfort is still helping.

As school returns to session, we hope to focus on meeting needs for students and teachers. All 750 students in Owsley County are currently attending school via virtual learning. Most have internet access at home, but for a few unable to afford it, we can provide service for \$10/month, plus a one-time \$10 connection fee. There are only a few families with this need.

When school returns in person for Owsley County, after the first 9-weeks, we hope to provide masks for all 750 students in Kindergarten-12th grade. We will work with independent mask makers to purchase masks, stretching our good even further by helping small business owners with income during the pandemic.
